

## OVERNIGHT TRIP RULES FOR STUDENT PARTICIPANTS

In addition to the rules listed below, students are to abide by the Code of Conduct printed in the Student Handbook. Dishonorable behavior is regarded as a **SERIOUS** breach of school rules and grounds for immediate disciplinary action. Furthermore, if there are any problems with any student participant or if any action brings discredit to Vail Unified School District, the student will be sent home at their own expense after their parents have been notified.

1. At no time are male students allowed to visit female students' rooms and vice versa.  
(Crossing the entrance of the door violates this rule)
2. Students will not wear or display offensive or immodest clothing.
3. Students will not possess and/or consume alcohol or tobacco.
4. Students will not possess and/or use drugs other than those prescribed to them by a doctor.
5. Students will not possess or use fireworks, lighters, explosives, firearms, or weapons of any kind.
6. Students will not abuse, deface or steal property/facilities.
7. Students will respect one another, staff, and adult leaders.
8. Students will dress appropriately as specified in the Student /Parent Handbook.
10. Students will respect and comply with the time schedules and curfews set by their trip sponsors.
11. Students will bring the necessary items specified for the particular trip by the trip sponsor.

This form must be signed by the student participant and parent or guardian in order for the student to attend the student activity overnight trip.
